

Apple Add-Up

Object: To cover more apples than the other player.

Number of Players: 2

To Play:

- ◆ Each player gets a copy of the apple tree game board. Decide who will go first.
- ◆ Take turns spinning. (Look at the picture to see how to use the spinner.) After spinning, cover **two** apples on your tree with the counters. The two numbers on the apples must add up to a number that matches the spinner. **Example:** Player 1 spins “Equal to 15.” Player 1 can cover 7 and 8, 5 and 10, 2 and 13, or any other combination of two apples that totals 15. Player 2 spins “More than 15.” Player 2 can cover any combination of two apples that totals more than 15.
- ◆ Once your counters are on the board, you can’t move them!
- ◆ If you can’t cover two apples to match the spinner, you’re out. The other player wins.

You Need:

- ◆ small counters
- ◆ pencil ◆ paper clip
