

## Firefighter Rescue



### What You'll Need:

- Cones
- Paper People Cut Outs
- Spring-Loaded Clothespins

### How to Play:

1. Split the kids into two teams: A and B
2. To start off Team A will be the Firefighters and Team B will be the Fire
3. Set the playing area up as follows

O=cone X=kid/fire

**Bucket**            X O X O X O X O X

**O' Paper** -----> **Safety**

**People**            O X O X O X O X O

4. Each kid from Team A has to rescue a paper person using their hands behind their back (or for added difficulty a clothespin behind their back) and get them to safety
5. If the *kid* is touched by the "fire", they have to go back to the beginning and try again. They only get 3 lives
6. If a paper person is taken by the "fire", then that kid's turn is over and the paper person is lost.
7. The goal is to get as many paper people to safety as possible
8. Once all the kids on Team A has gone, Team A and B switch places, and Team B tries to rescue as many paper people as possible
