

Four Corner Bug Lot (AKA Four Corner Car Lot)



How to play:

1. Split up the players into 4 equal groups, and have each group move to one corner of the gym. All these players are insect. Each corner is a colony of insects. For example, a swarm of Monarch butterflies, a city of ants, a hive of bees etc. All together, they make up the insect world.
2. Choose a player to stand in the middle of the gym with the sproutballs. That player is the Repellant.
3. Direct that player to yell the name of one of the colonies (i.e. "Monarch butterflies!"). That group of insects must run all the way around the gym (along the walls) before returning to their colony, as the Repellant throws a ball at the running insects. If a butterfly is hit while running around the perimeter of the gym, they must join the Repellant in the middle and throw balls at their fellow insects while wearing horrified, agonized expressions and crying (they were sprayed by a toxic chemical!).
4. Any time the Repellant in the middle needs to retrieve a ball, they may, but then they must return to the center of the gym before throwing it again. Allow the insects who made it around the gym without being hit to return to their colony.
5. If the Repellant in the center yells "Insect World!" then all players must run and make it back to their colony safely.
6. The last insect still running or still in his/her colony is the winner.

Let the winner now become the Repellant and the game starts over.
