## Glowing Firefly

**Component: Art**

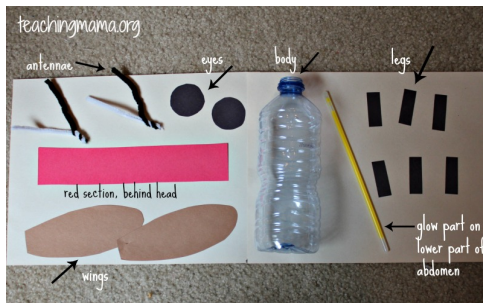
**Time: 30-45 minutes**



### Materials:

- Empty water bottle
- White and black pipe cleaners
- Black, red, brown construction paper
- Glow stick
- tape
- glue

### Procedure:



1. To prepare the craft, you will need to cut construction paper for the eyes, legs, wings, and a red section (which is behind their head). You can see in the above picture how to cut them out.

2. The antennae is black and white. Start twisting black and white pipe cleaners together

3. Then have them first tape the wings onto the water bottle. (We started out with just two wings, but learned later that they have 4 wings so we added two more wings underneath!)

4. Next, tape on the legs (3 on each side).

5. Then place the red strip of paper around the bottle (in front of the wings) and tape it to the bottle.

6. Then glue on the black eyes. Glue on the antennae (between the eyes).

7. Lastly, add the glow stick. Bend it in half and stick it through the opening of the bottle.
