## **Cotton Egg Art**

**Component:** Art

**Time:** 30 minutes



### **Materials:**

Cotton balls  
Paper plates  
Spring color tempera paint  
Paintbrushes  
clothespins

### **Procedure:**

1. Precut or have the students trace and cut out the giant egg shape from white paper. Squirt a few spring colors on paper plates and place in the center of the table space.
2. Have cotton balls, some with clothespins, for kids to dip in paint and dab on their egg shape. Some children might need the clothespin clipped to the cotton ball for easier grasping.
3. Encourage students to cover the whole egg and use patterns.
