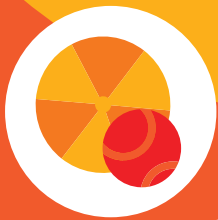

Financial assistance is based on verified income and completed paperwork. Applications are available online at southsoundymca.org or at the Briggs and Downtown/Plum Street facilities.

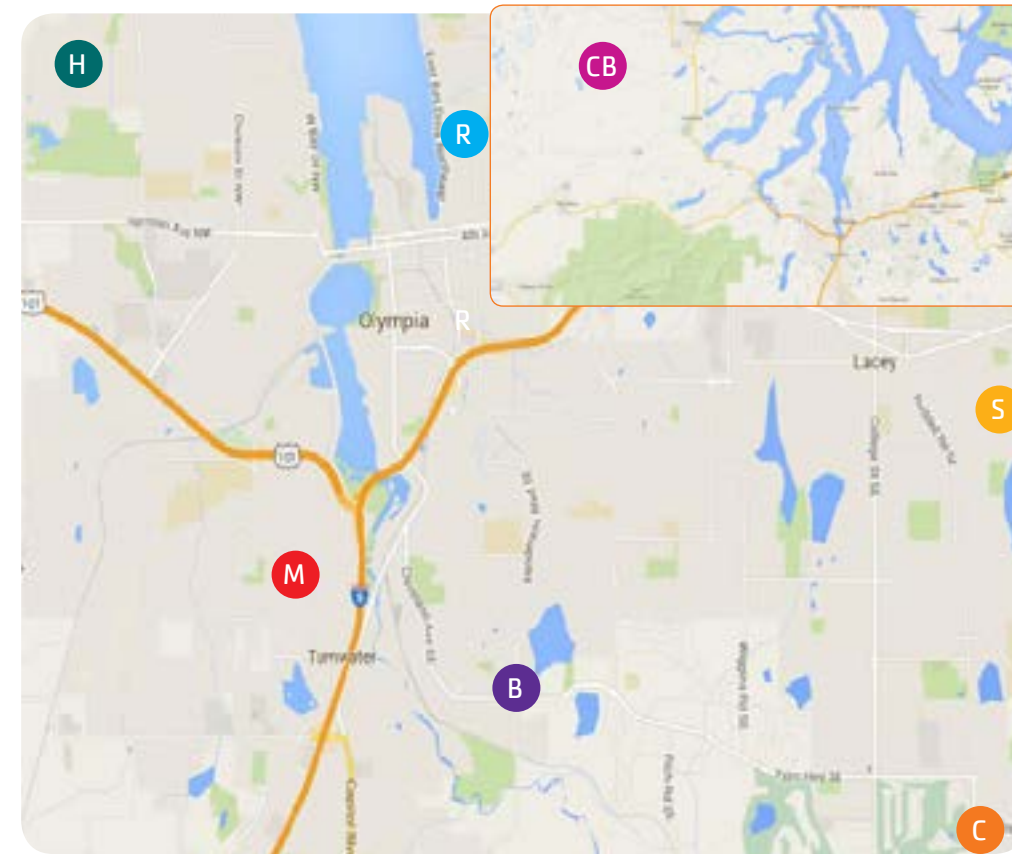

Refund Policy

All cancellations must be made in writing by completing the Credit and Refund Request Form, available at the Briggs YMCA or YMCA Child Development Office. Refunds will be reviewed and processed within 7 days. A \$20 non-refundable deposit per week of camp is required for registration. Cancellations and changes must be made by the Monday prior to the week of camp. Refunds are available and the deposit is transferable (if signing up for a different week of camp) only if changes are requested by the Monday prior to the week of camp. No refunds are allowed after payment due date. Refunds will be available in the form of system credits, by check, or by credit card (credit card refunds are available only if payment was originally made with credit card). A \$5 processing fee will apply to refunds originally paid by check or cash. Refunds are subject to approval.
