All Star Camp

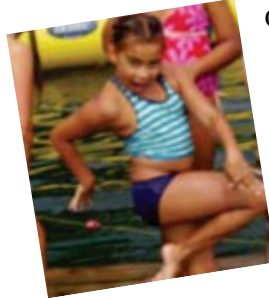
Entering Grades 1-6 - Olympia School Site
